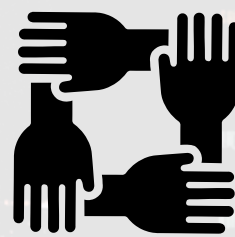

Looking for donations and other items of personal and or household basics donated.



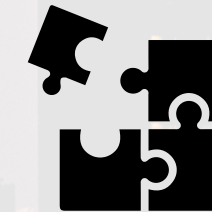
Co-op

Quarterly Events, themed with the season, to hit major fundraising goals. Raffle Prizes would come from workers and skill sharing [sanctioned work approved].

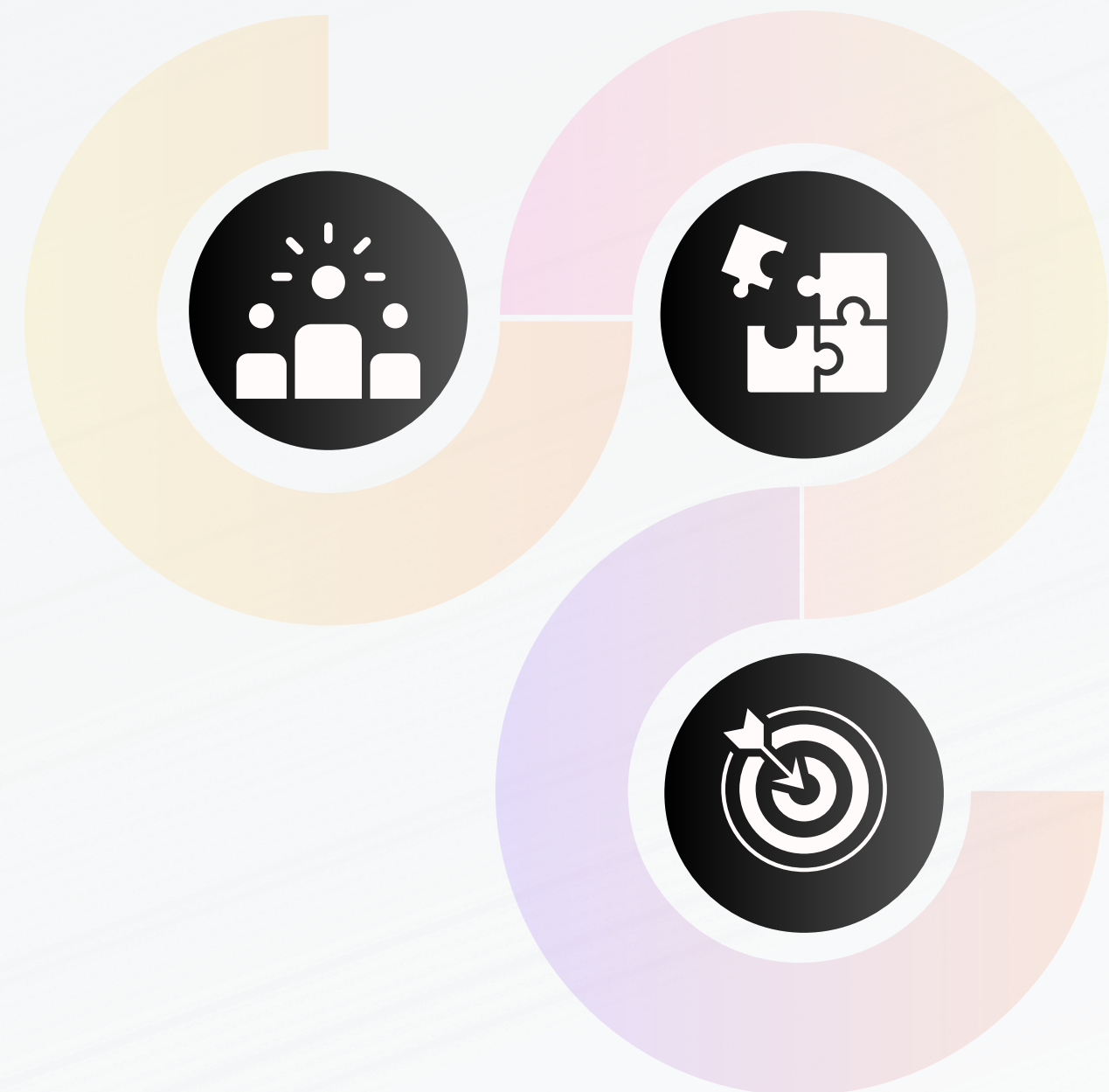

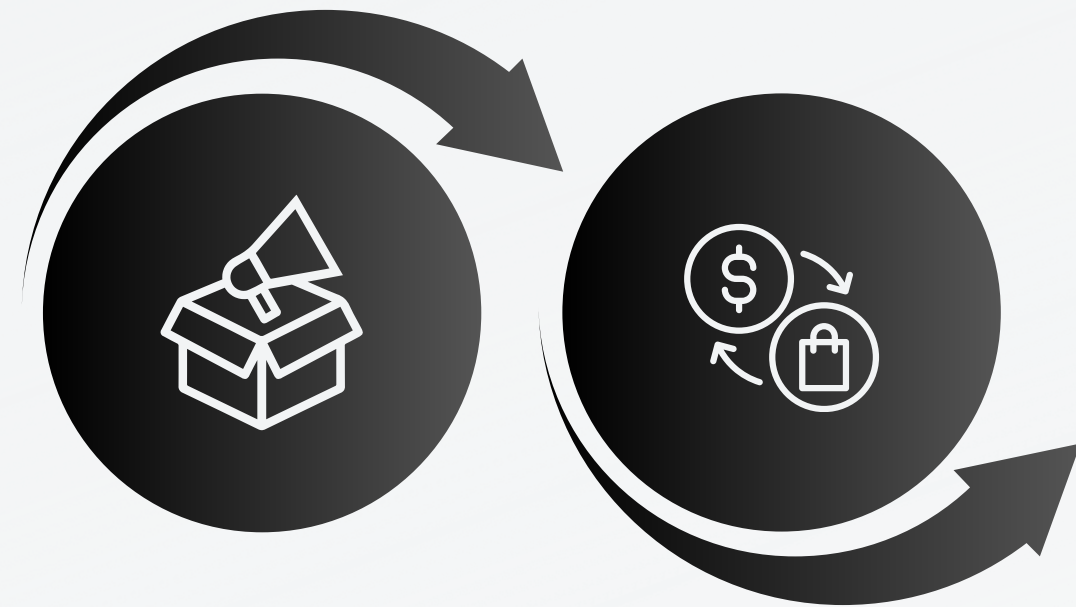

Learn to grow our community with classes of basic needs from self care, mental health, small home repair needs.

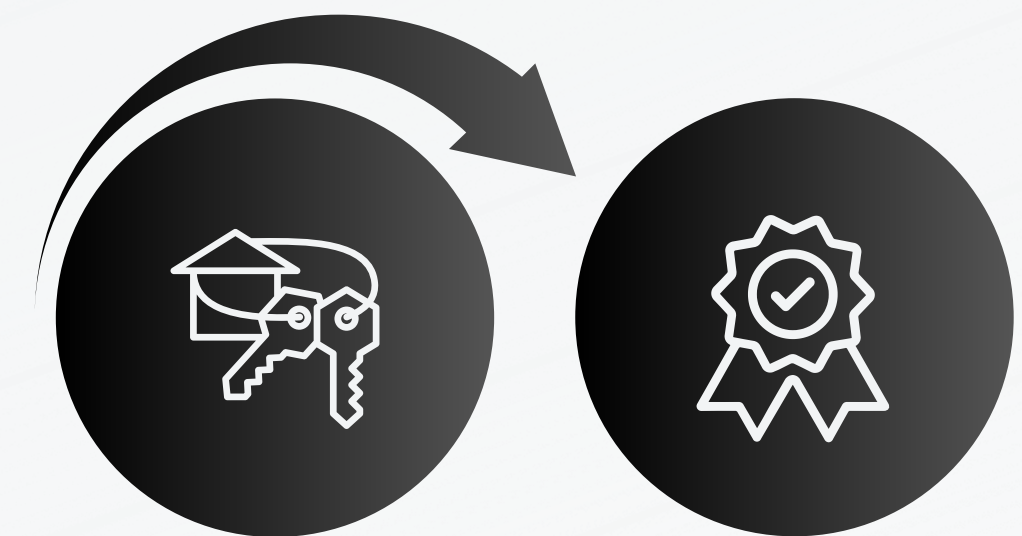


Dev Workshops

Setting up a table to show what resources are provided for our elderly community member and union members.

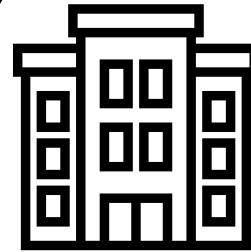


Volunteer Services

We will need volunteers for running classes, booths, set-up and tear downs, outreach, donation finders, and more.

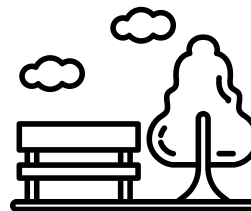
LOCATION IDEAS

Step one

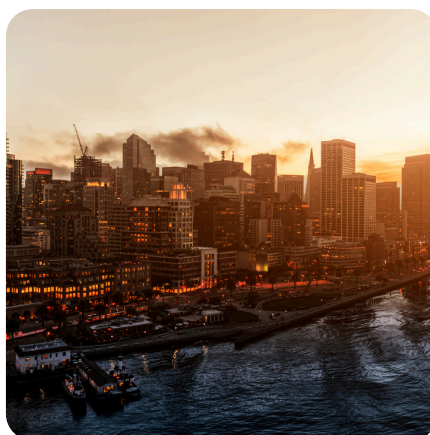
Present to our local union

01

Planning

03

04

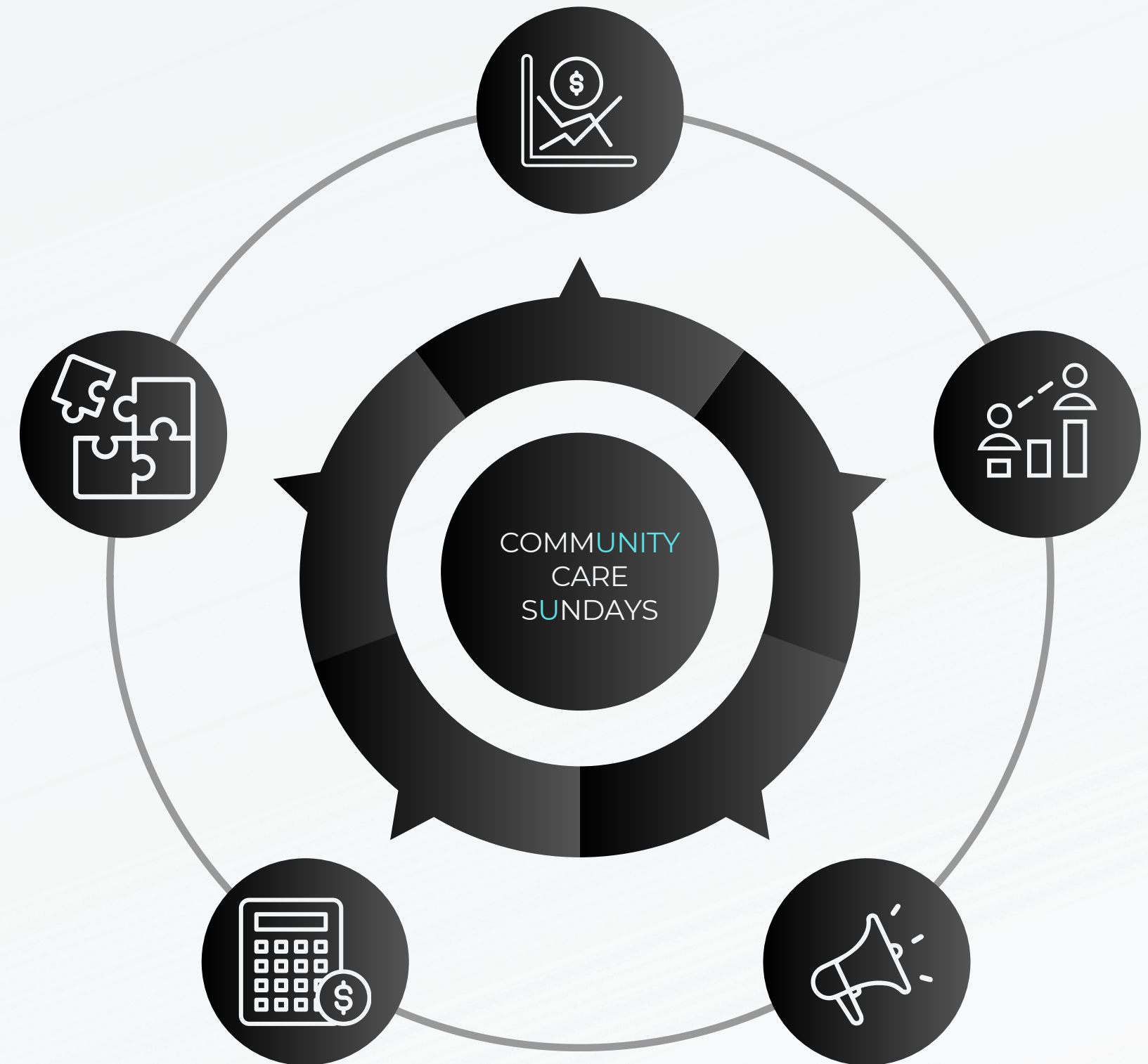
Execution
